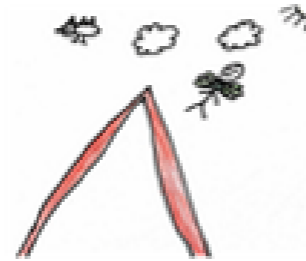

All the children in Room 3 have written amazing stories this year. We wish we could share them all but here are just a few...

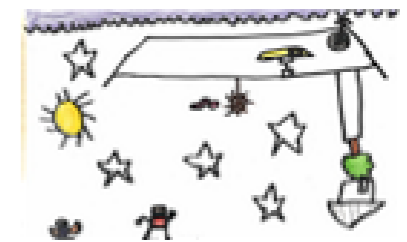
If I could fly...
