On November 8th, the Senior School visited the Auckland Zoo as part of our inquiry studies focused on what makes a great zoo. During our trip, we explored

the Five Domains Model of Animal Welfare that the Auckland Zoo implements, which includes: Nutrition, Environment, Health, Behaviour, and Mental or Psychological State of the animals. This experience deepened our understanding of how zoos prioritise the well-being of their animals.

We were fortunate to witness the last days of our beloved elephant, Burma, at the Auckland Zoo. She has now been relocated to the Monarto Safari Park in Australia, where she will be joined by a herd of four other elephants in a spacious 12-hectare habitat.
